## InCK Business Highlight Carmi Compassion Center

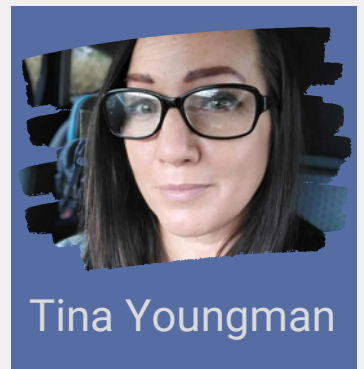


Carmi Compassion Center provides free clothing, shoes, home goods, appliances, and financial assistance to low-income families living in the Carmi school district.
