Integrated Care for Adults (InCA) will help navigate the care services needed to optimize the health and social needs of adult Medicaid beneficiaries age 21 years and older living in our five-county region of Saline, Gallatin, White, Wayne, and Hamilton. InCA partners include Southern Illinois Healthcare (SIH), Harrisburg Medical Center/Mulberry Center, Ferrell Hospital, and the Gallatin County Wellness Center. With the support of our partners, InCA can communicate directly with providers to address the social and health

needs of the client to aid in the best outcomes in care.


**Staff Spotlight**
