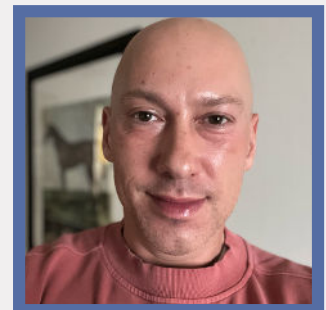

The Recovery Resource Center is a central point of information to help individuals and families navigate substance use treatment and recovery services. The Recovery Resource Center staff are equipped to answer questions, initiate the treatment process, make referrals as needed, provide links to additional services and provide information regarding recovery support services in our communities.

I am Chris Dennis the ROSC and Overdose Prevention Coordinator. I lead the SI SUPRT council, which is a Recovery Oriented System of Care (ROSC). There are ROSC's all over the state, working alongside each other to address substance use and promote recovery in our communities. One of our central missions is to reduce stigma toward people who struggle with addiction. We meet on the first Wednesday of every month, and anyone is welcome to attend our meetings! Our Council is a coalition of community members devoted to addressing the needs of people seeking or already in recovery. I also provide overdose education and distribute Narcan to dozens of counties in southern Illinois. Evidence shows any kind of healthcare intervention, including access to Narcan, increases the likelihood that a person will find recovery.

S.U.D.S. + Laundry Event

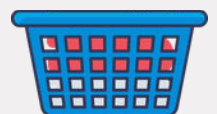
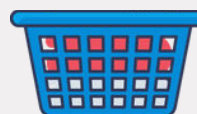
