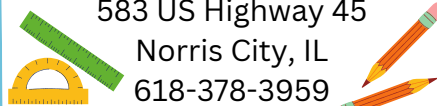

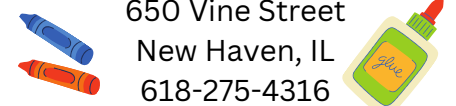

Are you a guardian of a young person with a mental health diagnosis and need help?...A FAMILY RESOURCE DEVELOPER CAN HELP!

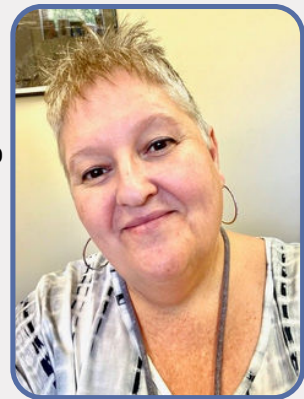
A Family Resource Developer may be able to provide the following to your family:

- Provide information from your child's provider about their mental illness.
- Assist in finding transportation solutions for appointments.
- Assist your counselor in finding out more about your family's unique strengths and needs.
- Support you in seeking the best possible outcomes for your child and family.
- Assist in advocating for your child by having the parent or guardian attend monthly PACE meetings, or our weekly Parenting Program, and your child's counseling sessions.
