ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must be a high school senior in Saline, White, or Gallatin Counties.
- 2. Must be an entering freshman at a college or university for the 2024-2025 academic year.
- 3. Must declare Human Service/Health Care Service intent.
- 4. Must submit 2 letters of recommendation from an adult not related to the applicant, such as a teacher or a community leader.
- 5. Write a personal essay, not to exceed one page, double-spaced, typed, on future goals in Human Services/Health Care Services.

PROCEDURES

Completed applications must be received by April 12, 2024. The scholarship committee will review applications. Students will be notified by the end of their school year. Selected applicants may be subject to an interview upon the request of the scholarship committee. Students not selected will be notified shortly thereafter.
