It takes a Village to keep children Healthy!

How to prepare your young child if they are getting a vaccine, tips to help make the moment go smoothly.

Open the conversation

. *Ask your child how they're feeling about their upcoming vaccination. Listen to their thoughts and any concerns and be ready to respond to their questions. Keep in mind that children look to adults for appropriate emotional reactions to a situation. Even if you are worried for your child knowing that they might be uncomfortable during their vaccination, try not to overshare your fears.

Keep responses kid-friendly

Children have a right to information about the vaccination process, but it should be riangleright explained to them in an age-appropriate way that is easy for them to understand.

Create a comforting distraction

★During the vaccination appointment, you can help keep your child's mind off the shot by creating a comforting distraction. Bring your child's favourite toy or tell them their favourite story. Reassure them that everything is going to be okay and that they're being very brave – even if they cry or get upset.

Soothe them after the shots

Before leaving your child's appointment, speak to their doctor about possible side effects of the vaccine and what you can do to help those at home, such as using a SIC Career Camp, Harrisburg- July 8th- cold cloth on the injection site. Pay extra close attention to your child for the next few days to make sure that they aren't doing or feeling anything out of the ordinary. If so, call your child's doctor for advice.
